(Manchester, CT – February 2016) — Making boxes might appear to be a simple process. But when shipping a large jet engine part valued at quarter million dollars or 20 foot long helicopter blades, the transportation container must be impeccably designed, inside and out.

All schematics are now developed through two- and three-dimensional design software, such as AutoCAD and SOLIDWORKS.

Champlin's design engineers are encouraged to get out from behind their desks, often visiting customer's facilities so they can examine and assess the valuable products in need of protective containers. For critical projects, they also observe the construction process in the manufacturing shop to ensure precision.
